Admission Information



Wakasugi Junior High School hopes ...

- Regardless of age or nationality, students who seek to re-learn can experience the joy of learning and try to achieve their goals and dreams confidently through learning at this school.
- By collaborating with others of various ages or nationalities, students can recognize and appreciate each other's virtues.

1 Who can enroll at this night school

Persons who meet all the following criteria and want to re-learn at junior high school.

- People who live in Fukui, or those who work in Fukui. Nationality is not a requirement.
- Persons over school age (Persons who were born before April 1, 2012)
- People who meet one of the following criteria
 - Those who were unable to complete compulsory education.
 - Those who were unable to learn enough or attend school due to ill-health or absenteeism, etc.
- ◇ Persons who will be a student of any schools in 2026 are not permitted to enroll

2 Grade

- In principle, students will start from the first grade.
- Based on your history of learning or situation, you can even start from the second or third grade or mid-year.

3 Period of Study

- Usually, three years are needed to graduate.
- You can even request to repeat studying in the same grade for a few years if needed.

4 What will be studied

- You will study Japanese, social studies, math, science, music, arts, health and physical education, technology and home economics, and English. Furthermore, you will also have classes of moral education, integrated study, and extra-curricular activities.
- You can take basic Japanese classes or learn elementary school subjects.
- We are planning school events such as field trips, cultural festivals, and ball-game recreation.

5 When and How long to study.

- You will have 5 school days each week, from Monday to Friday.
- You will study from 5:45 to 9:00 p.m. each day.
- One class is 40 minutes long, and you will have 4 classes each day.

6 Fees

- Tuition, textbook fees, and admission fees are not needed.
- Materials fees or transportation fares are needed.

7 Commuting to School

- You can use buses, trains, bicycles, and a school bus.
- Commuting to school by private car or motorcycle is permitted with certain conditions.

8 Process of Admission

 Apply for admission to Wakasugi Junior High School (After the interview)	After you finish your interview, you need to submit the documents below. ● Required documents. ☐ Application form ※ It is available at the front desk of the Prefecture, City, and Town Board of Education. You can also download it on our website. Print it out and fill in the form. ☐ A copy of your certificate of residence ※ It does not need to include your individual number (= My Number) ☐ Certificate of employment (Only for those who live outside the prefecture and work within the prefecture) ☐ 460-yen-worth stamps (They are needed for the return postage) ● Submission deadline ・ ・ ・ December 4th, 2026 ※ Please call us if you want to apply after the deadline. ● How to submit ・ Required documents should be posted to Wakasugi JHS by registered mail. ・ Postage costs must be covered by the senders. ・ Please call us if posting documents is difficult. ○ 〒918-8575 35-21, Wakasugi-Cho, Fukui City, Fukui Prefecture

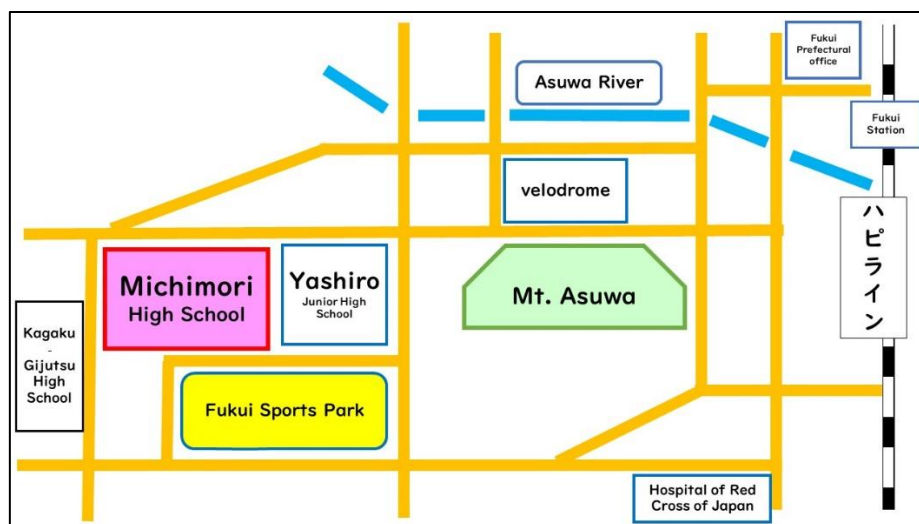

10 Access

- Fukui Station to Wakasugi Junior High School

Keifuku Bus Route 70, “Undo-Kouen Line”

Take the bus from platform 4 of the JR Fukui Station West Exit bus terminal.

The bus leaves Fukui Station at 5:00 p.m. and arrives at Michimori High School at 5:12 p.m.

- Wakasugi JHS to Fukui Station

Keifuku Bus Route 70, “Undo-Kouen Line”

It will take 12 minutes. Get off at “Michimori High School” bus stop.
